

**SPAN 386 – EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING
EARNING CREDIT
Spain in Alcalá Program Spring 2008**

Internship credit for Spanish 386 may be earned for unpaid internships in which the Spanish language and cultures play an important role. Please note that credit can only be awarded for the semester in which you are actually working at your site. Credit earned for Spanish 386 will be elective credit and will not count toward a Spanish major or minor.

You may earn a minimum of 3 OR a maximum of 6 credits for Spanish 386. The number of credits earned is based on the number of hours at the site as outlined below.

3 credits = 135 total hours

5 credits = 225 total hours

4 credits = 180 total hours

6 credits = 270 total hours

Student responsibilities:

1. Once you have been offered a position through the University of Alcalá, you must be sure to have a Site Supervisor.
2. Fill out the Internship Learning Proposal completely.
3. Once the form is complete and signed by you and the Site Supervisor, return the proposal to Manel Lacorte, Resident Director of the program for Spring 2008.
4. When you return the completed proposal, the resident director will confirm your registration for the course and the correct section number.
5. One week prior to the end of the semester, you must turn in a letter from your Site Supervisor on letterhead detailing what you did, how long you were there, and the Site Supervisor's personal evaluation of your performance. In addition, you must also turn in a 2-3 page paper in Spanish (Times 12, line space 1.5., 1" lower and upper margin, 1.25" left/right margin) explaining what you did and how it applied to your study of Spanish.
